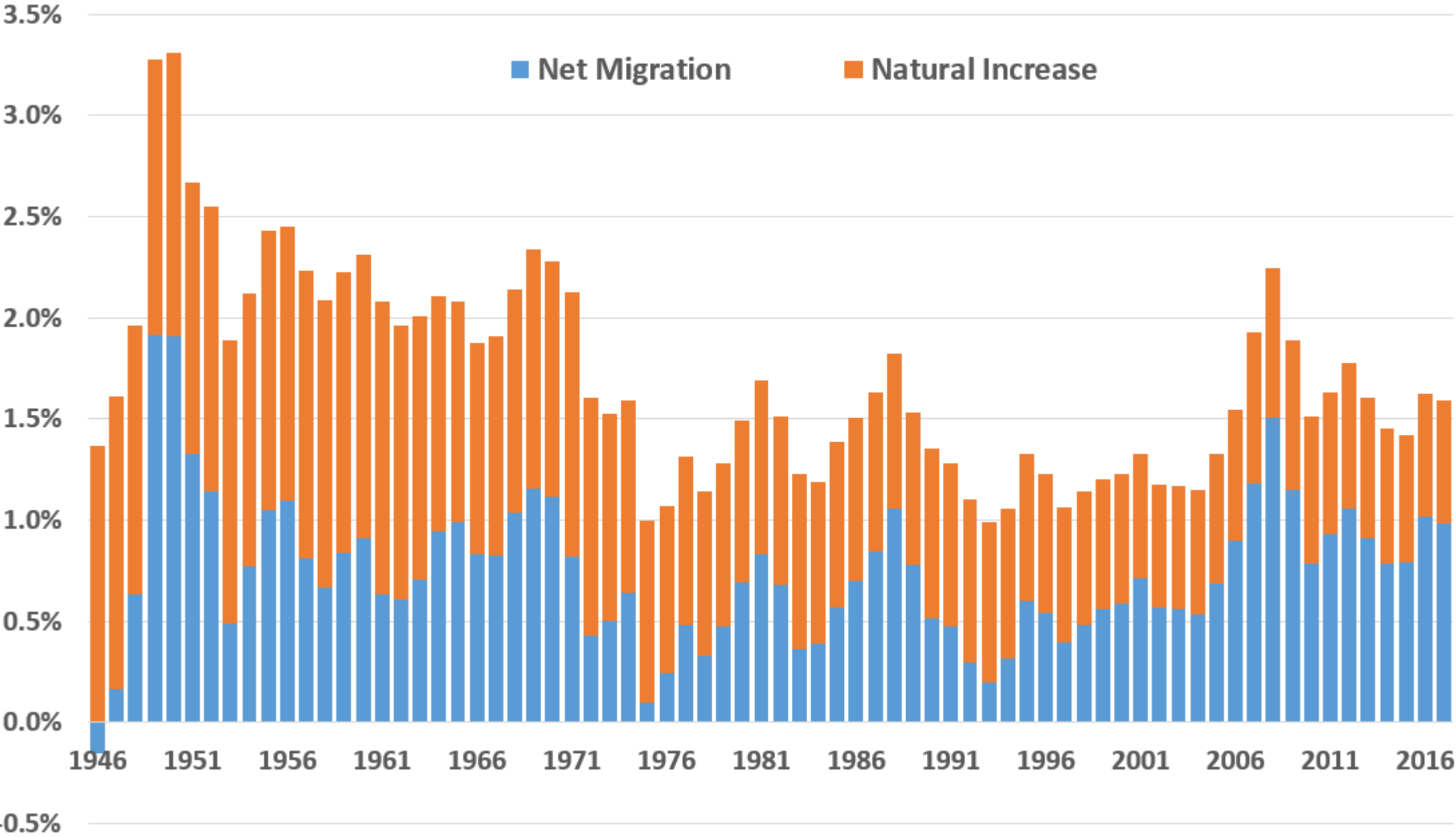

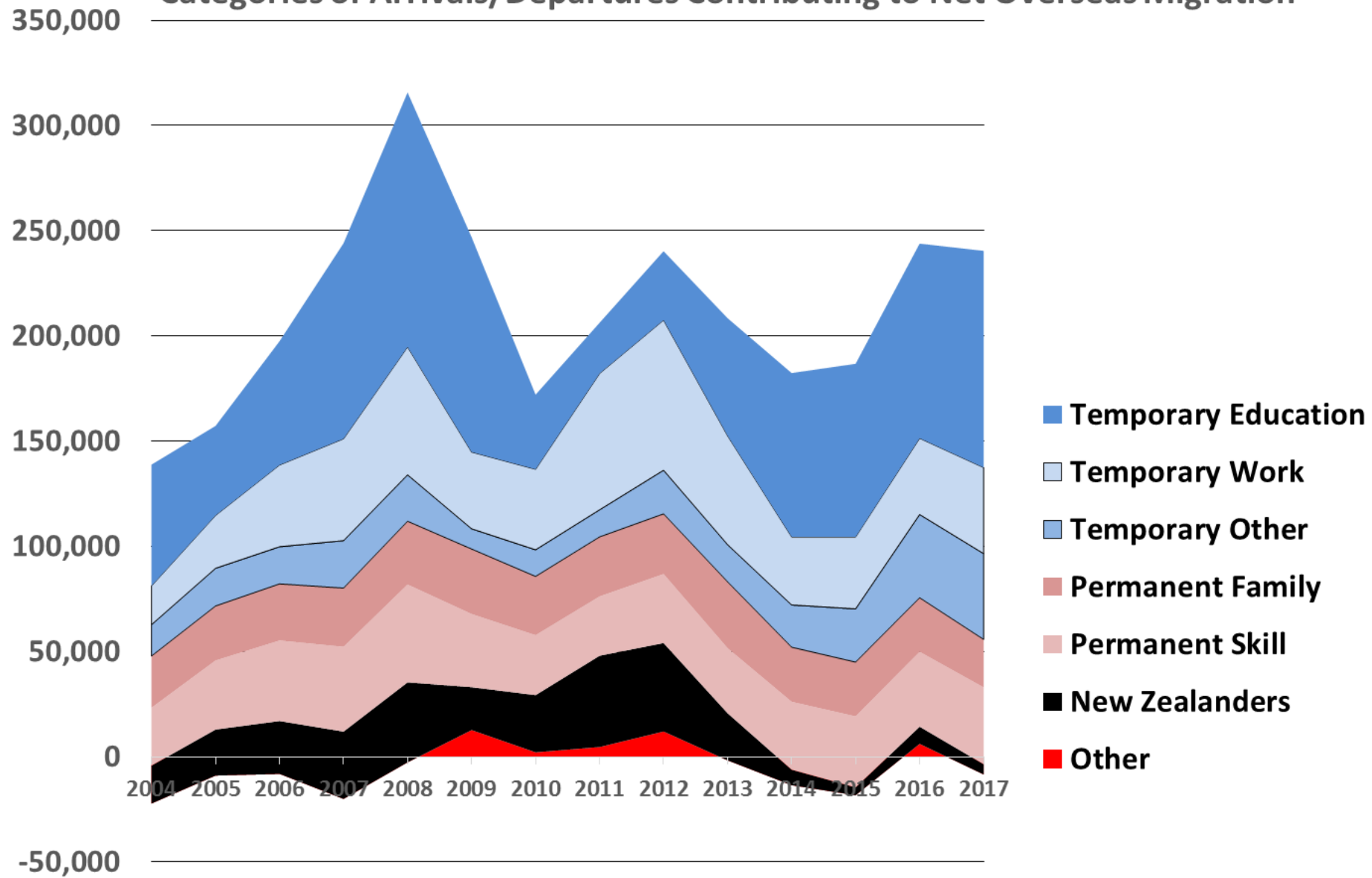

Some alignment of interest Problems in Australia

- Federal Governments use high migration to take credit for GDP
- No Treasury costing of long-term Environmental /Infrastructure Impact
- State Governments have to build the infrastructure in areas
- State Government tells local councils they have to make room for more people

Some alignment of interest Problems in Australia

- Council residents say no one asked them about migration levels
- Suburban social cohesion is starting to suffer
- Federal Government collects more taxes than they need which means States have to beg for funding to cover infrastructure for migration
- Federal Government uses temporary migration to dampen wages growth

Some alignment of interest Problems in Australia

- Reserve Bank and Big Business like this
- Federal Government has cut University funding and allowed Unis to recruit unlimited number of foreign students who pay higher fees. These extra fees go more to researchers than teachers.
